CALL FOR PAPERS

The 10th World Congress of Accounting Educators, co-organized by the IAAER, the EAAT and the TÜRMOB, will be held on November 9-11th, 2006 in Istanbul-TURKEY. Istanbul is a city of wonders. It is situated between two continents: Europe and Asia. The congress will be organized at the ICEC, the Istanbul Convention and Exhibition Center.

Note: Papers submitted before submission deadline (April 30, 2006) will be considered for best paper awards.

CRITERIA FOR SUBMISSION OF PAPERS FOR THE CONGRESS

Manuscripts should be of a sufficient academic standard and should be of interests to accounting educators, researchers and practitioners.

1. Manuscripts must be written in English and must not have been published or accepted for publication elsewhere at the time of submission. Manuscripts must be typed double-spaced and use a 12 point easily legible font (Times New Roman), and margins should be at least 2.5 cm. or 1" all round. Manuscripts must include an abstract of no more than 400 words, and up to ten keywords.
2. All manuscripts should be submitted by email to the congress organizing committee (selviyak@istanbul.edu.tr and pekdemir@tnn.net) by **April 30, 2006**. You should submit two files. One file should be an Adobe PDF file free of any identification of the author and affiliation. Another file should include the title page and should be in MS Word 97 or later versions. The title page in the Word file should include the paper title, author name and affiliation, contact address, phone number, fax, e-mail address, and any appropriate acknowledgements. You should also indicate the contact author. You should name your files using the last names of the authors.
3. If you would like to have your conference submission considered for publication in the *Journal of International Financial Management & Accounting* (JIFMA), you need to also copy your submission to C.S. Agnes Cheng (acheng@uh.edu). If you would like to have your conference submission considered for publication in a special issue of *Accounting Education* (AE), you need to also copy your submission to the editor of Accounting Education, Richard M.S Wilson, at R.M.Wilson@Lboro.ac.uk. You need to follow AE's Notes for Contributors (available in any issue of AE, or on the publisher's website: www.tandf.co.uk/journals, follow links to Accounting Education).
4. When you email your submission, please indicate your research subject in parentheses on the subject line. Below are some examples of the subject line:
"General submission (*your subject*)"
"JIFMA fast track (*your subject*)" (note: copy your submission to acheng@uh.edu)
"AE Special Issue (*your subject*)" (note: copy your submission to R.M.Wilson@Lboro.ac.uk)
5. You will receive a confirmation within a week of your submission. If you do not receive the confirmation, it is your responsibility to send us an inquiry.
6. Notice of acceptance for presentation will be sent out by **May 31, 2006**.
7. We also consider submission of abstracts by the April 30th deadline; however, your full paper must be submitted by **August 31, 2006** if you are accepted for presentation at the conference. The abstract submissions will not be reviewed for publication in JIFMA, AE and best paper awards and are restricted to present in the Forum paper sessions.
